

CAUTION: ATTACH FEET BEFORE OPERATING

DO NOT OPERATE WITH FEET MISSING.



Break apart the two Plastic Feet, as shown.



BACK OF FAN

Slide Feet into Slots in the bottom of the metal housing until they snap into position.

It is not intended to be used in commercial or industrial settings.

WARNING

This appliance has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). To reduce the risk of electric shock, this plug is intended to fit in a polarized outlet only one way. **MATCH WIDE BLADE OF PLUG TO WIDE SLOT, FULLY INSERT.** If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature.

This plug is a safety feature. To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock and personal injury, do not remove, replace, repair or tamper with the originally supplied plug. If the Fan does not function properly, it may be due to the safety device incorporated in this plug. Return to an authorized service center or call 800-233-0268, Monday - Friday, between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm EST. If the plug warning label is missing or damaged, call the toll free number for a replacement label.

GENERAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Never insert fingers, pencils, or other foreign objects through the grill.
2. Disconnect Fan when moving it from one location to another.
3. Be sure that the Fan is on a stable surface when operating, to avoid the chance of it overturning.
4. Disconnect Fan when removing grills for cleaning. Reinstall grills before reconnecting to power supply.
5. **WARNING:** To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock or personal injury:
 - a) Do not use this Fan with any solid-state speed control device.
 - b) Unplug Fan before cleaning or servicing.
 - c) If you disassemble your Fan, completely reassemble before plugging into outlet, according to instructions.

OPERATION

1. Plug the Fan into any standard 120V AC household outlet.
2. Using the rotary switch, set the desired Fan speed.

MAINTENANCE

1. To clean your Fan, use a soft cloth moistened with a mild soap solution. **NEVER IMMERSE ELECTRICAL PARTS IN WATER.** Avoid using gasoline, benzene, thinner, hard cleansers, etc. Be certain that the Fan is completely dry before plugging in.
2. Lubrication is not required as your Fan has permanently lubricated bearings.
3. Store in a clean and dry area when not in use.
